Release Time Bible Education

HopeStrong Released Time Bible Education is an opportunity for Circleville City School students in 5th –12th grade. Bible classes are offered during the school day with parent consent, are located off school property, and are funded by the local community. Students are released to leave school, for about one hour, one day a week. Classes are offered during non-instructional times in the school day. Transportation is provided by HopeStrong and trained volunteers accompany students from the school building to a nearby location for a non-denominational Bible class. Volunteers go through an extensive approval and training process, have background checks, and are committed to ensuring child welfare and safety during program times.

Program Details: Students will be transported by HopeStrong vans to Nicholas Drive Church, located at 400 Nicholas Drive in Circleville, Ohio. Middle school students may walk with volunteers, weather permitting. The high school class will follow a hybrid model with classes being held at Ohio Christian University and Nicholas Drive. Parents will be sent a copy of this hybrid schedule.

Weekly Schedule:

Middle School: Tuesdays 6th Graders: 11:17am-12:15pm, 7th Graders: 10:24-11:25am, 8th Graders: 9:58-10:56am

High School: Wednesdays-11:42-1:04 pm, Elementary: Thursdays-12:50-1:40 pm

If your child is interested in participating in HopeStrong Bible Education, please complete and return the parent permission slip below to your child’s school office. Program participation may be limited by available classroom space. Classes begin the week of September 19th, 2022. Enrollment is open year long. If students are enrolled in HopeStrong, they must attend when present at school. For more information contact Kim Martin at the phone number or email listed above.
